In his first week alone, the many ways he has excelled are as follows:


- He came to the school bottle feeding and by the end of that first week, he graduated to not just a sip cup, but a handle held drinking cup – and that, with control and without assistance. In fact, at home he began demanding the cup instead of the bottle and now refuses a bottle when given, because he has apparently 'put it behind him.'
- He made an accelerated transition to potty training, which had only just begun with minimal success at home, but had grown into a well adjusted 3 to 4 visits to the potty per day, often comfortably removing his own diaper in anticipation of a visit to the bathroom. In addition, he has also incorporated clear verbal cues ("doo-doo, pee-pee") to indicate his need to use the potty.
- In general, his speech has grown in clarity and his comprehension of verbal commands as well. Prior to Little People, his child care kept him at home, not very interactive with other children his age. However, his positive stimulation at Little People was so radical that for a few days it was a little challenging to get him to wind down for bed time. He was blown away with all of his favorite things to do at once so he'd come home literally bouncing off the walls of the crib!

Because of the welcoming environment he received even on an exploratory visit, the 'first week' transition that most parents are very cautious about, never actually happened. He acted as if he had been living there for a few years and even cried when it was time to go home.

We are very happy and encouraged to have found a situation that can confidently boast a healthy marriage of fun, professionalism and diversity in our child's early education.
